We will visit place value and calculation methods early in the term, then go on to exploring 2d shapes, time, proportional reasoning, and strive towards our goal to know all the timetables by the end of the year.

Science


This term we will be covering 'Animals including humans'. We will look at the relationship between predator and prey, different types of teeth and how food is digested.

Creative Curriculum

Our new topic is learning all about the Greeks. We will be able to locate Greece on a map and look at famous landmarks from the country, such as the Parthenon Temple in Acropolis. We will study the ancient Greece civilisation and discover how this has influenced the lives of people over different periods, and consider the use of reliable historical resources in helping us understand this era of history. We will also learn about the Greek Gods and study Greek art and architecture and develop our Art & DT skills to use clay to create
