Maths

This term we will be learning how to count correctly. We will be counting by rote but also counting to demonstrate 1 to 1 with numbers up to at least 10. Please count everything at home. How many steps are there? How many fish fingers are you having for your tea? How many biscuits have you got?

Writing

We will start to work on pencil control and writing patterns. Further into the term, children will start to write recognisable letters and their own names.

Many of the activities in the Nursery will help the children to develop their fine motor skills. e.g. playing with the dough / threading bobbins / using tweezers.

Reading

As well as developing our writing skills, we will begin to learn and recognise sounds through daily phonics in class. This will help your child to develop the skills needed for reading.

Please read your own story books and picture books at home to/with your child to encourage their love of reading and books.

Creative Curriculum

Our topic is focused on "Myself.". We will encourage the children to name the parts of their bodies / talk about their families and their pets. We will also discuss our 5 Senses and how we use them. We will be reading stories and singing songs linked to this theme. There will be many creative activities. For example the children will make handprints and footprints / they will paint and draw pictures of themselves.

All of the children are now in the Nursery and are all settling in to the routines. Please talk to us anytime.
