


Hetton-Le-Hole Nursery School Newsletter

What's been happening in school?

Autumn is here, and all of the children have really loved exploring and learning all about this season. We have been exploring all of the items that were returned in the Autumn bags, and it's been great hearing about your Autumnal adventures.

Baby Room



Our youngest learners have been busy exploring autumnal vegetables using all of their senses in their soil tray. They explored the vegetables, using the tools to bury them in the soil!

The babies have also been busy investigating all of the exciting autumn objects that they have brought in. They have really been fascinated by the colourful leaves in our Baby Garden.

2-3 Year Old Room



In the 2-3 year old room, the children have shown an interest in printing and they have been printing with the vegetables from their Harvest exploration area! They have been fascinated as they have explored the different marks they can make.

Outside, the children have been further exploring different ways of making marks through mud painting! They have been busy collecting mud and adding water to it so they can make marks using it.
