KS1 Homework Projects

For your homework project choose at least two activities below to complete for Monday 16th December

Art and Design

Get creative! Design and make one of the buildings from around where you live using materials you can find at home. You might want to build a model of the church, the school or your house! Use cardboard boxes, Lego and other materials to help you! Perhaps even a Windmill, like the one in our school logo?

If you prefer drawing and painting, then create an observational drawing of a building near to where you live. Look carefully at the detail. What is the building made out of? How many doors and windows are there?

Science

What kinds of animals live in our countryside, surrounding Greens Norton? Research into what your animal needs to survive in its habitat. Perhaps build a model of the habitat your animal lives in - labelling the different features of it.

Geography

Explore the village with an adult and look around for different types of buildings. When you get home create a map of where you walked and try to show some of the key features of the village. For example, you might want to show the school, church, post office and village hall on your map.

Geography

Greens Norton is a village and it is located near Northampton which is a town. Can you research into another town or city of your choice? Using ICT can you create a poster or a PowerPoint about your chosen city or town to present to the class. What is there to do there? How many people live there? How can you get there?

History

Greens Norton is a historical village. Can you research into how the village has changed over time? You might want to do this by safely using the internet to research or you might know a friend or family member that can remember some facts about how the village might have changed. Present your findings as a poster or a PowerPoint presentation.

Maths

Complete and present a tally chart or a bar graph of the different types of houses in your street: Detached, semi-detached, cottage, flat, bungalow... Or in a bigger area of the village which could be highlighted on a map.
