Just a reminder that on your child's first day of absence please telephone school and inform us of the reason for the absence. This is to try and prevent the spreading of sickness and germs.

Operation Christmas Child

With Christmas fast approaching we are once again helping to support this worthy cause. Instead of asking you to fill a shoe box we are asking for you to donate an item for the shoe boxes. Each box costs around £5 to mail therefore any donations towards postage would be very welcome. We are asking year groups to provide different items as follows:

- **Nursery & Reception - small toy eg yoyo, bouncy ball, doll, teddy**
- **Year 1 & 2 - stationery eg pens, pencils, rubbers, colouring books**
- **Year 3 & 4 - hats, scarf, gloves, bobbles, clips**
- **Year 5 - toiletries - toothpaste, toothbrush, facecloth**
- **Year 6 - sweets - not chocolate and over 6 months sell by date**

If you would like to fill your own shoe box they will be gratefully received, please collect a leaflet from the office. **The closing date to bring your items/boxes into school is Wednesday 30 October.**

Emergency contact information

It is important that emergency contact details for your child are kept up to date. In an emergency situation we will access your information to contact you immediately. If you are unavailable we will contact the other names you have provided. We will also use these contact numbers if your child does not arrive at school with no explanation. The LA also require this information to send out important documents eg high school applications.

Car park

The school car park is for **staff and official visitors only**. Parents are not allowed to park in the school grounds. This is for the health and safety of all our pupils. When parking outside the school grounds please do not block the residents' entrances.

School meal payments - School Grid

Meals must be paid for, in advance, on a Monday morning unless you have signed up to a direct debit. If you get into arrears with your child's account then you will be asked to bring a packed lunch in for your child and they will not be allowed a school dinner until the account is cleared and a direct debit has been set up.
