As the weather changes and the nights draw in children begin to spend more time indoors and potentially on their electronic devices. The children were very excited this week to visit the *Book Bus* and as always their manners and behaviour were exemplary. The bus sold an amazing total of £727 of books, resulting in £109 commission for the school.

The children listened well and showed that they already knew lots of ways to keep safe, however, I think we all learned some new things and the children were shocked that anyone would stop on the yellow zig zags outside a school (even just to drop off!) when he explained how dangerous that is.
