### It has been a short but busy week in Year 6

**English** –The children explored descriptive language for a setting by imagining they were David Attenborough providing a voiceover for a video about the Alps. They incorporated these descriptions into their own writing.

**Maths** – In Maths, the children have worked on short multiplication and multiplying 4-digit numbers by 2-digit numbers using problem solving.

**Science** – The children have explored natural selection and have started researching Charles Darwin and the discoveries he has made.

**Ivrit** – Year 6 carried on with the topic called 'My bedroom'. The class will be studying the topic for this half term. The key vocabulary includes: מדף (Madaf – shelf) מגירה (Megera – drawer) מנורה (Menora – lamp) שטיח (Shatiach – carpet) דלת (Delet – door) חלון (Chalon – window) ארון (Aron – cupboard) שולחן (Shulchan – table) מיטה (Mita – bed) מראה (Maraa – mirror) פה (Pach – bin) חדר (Cheder – room) מיטות (Mitot – beds) ארונות (Aronot – cupboards) מדפים (Madafim – shelves) מנורות (Menorot – lamps) דלתות (Dlatot – doors) חלונות (Chalonot – windows) שטיחים (Shtichim – carpets). The focus of this week and the next is creating sentences with the following propositions: בתוך (Betoch – inside) ב (Be – in) ליד (Leiad – next to) על (Al – on top) מתחת (Mitachat – underneath).

**JS** – In this very short week we have started to prepare for Yom Kippur by looking at the Tishrei calendar and how the Torah describes Yom Kippur. The children also enjoyed baking apple and honey biscuits in the spirit of Rosh Hashanah.
