SCHOOL PHOTOGRAPHS



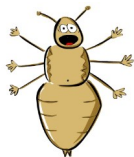

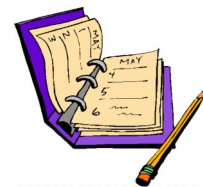
