Dear parents, pupils, governors, staff and parishioners,

The month of October is a traditional time to pray The Rosary: a set of prayers to God, our Lady and the Holy Spirit.

In Monday's Mission Assembly children will be learning that, after reflecting on a passage of scripture (called a 'mystery'), we say a set of prayers (called a 'decade') including the Our Father, ten Hail Marys and a Glory Be. We use the beads of the rosary to help us keep count, but fingers can work too! You might like to pray the rosary with your child this October:

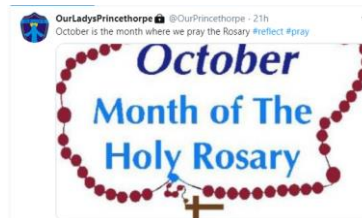
### PTA
