### English

As communicators, we will be imitating stories and re-telling a familiar story. We will be learning the features of instructions and writing our own set of instructions. We will also be using past tense to recount a story.

## What is special about Belgrave?



### Geography:

As Geographers we will identify United Kingdom, Leicester and Belgrave on a map. We will be studying our local area, Belgrave, in detail and the children will be mapping their walk to Belgrave. We will also be identifying the human and physical geography of Belgrave.

### Maths

As mathematicians, we will be following the National Curriculum for Year 1. We will be learning to count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number and we will learn to identify one more and one less of any given number. We will also learn to identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least. We will handle common 2-D and 3-D shapes, naming these and related everyday objects and learn to recognise these shapes in different orientations and sizes.

### Art and Design:

We will be using different paint techniques to create lights and fireworks display. We will also be sketching and using water colours.

### WHY?

It is important that the children build on their knowledge of their environment and learn about the local area that they live in. This topic offers the children the opportunity to learn more about their local area, Belgrave.

### Design & Technology:

We will be using different materials to make collages and constructing different types of objects. We will also be using play dough to make different objects.

### Science:

As scientists we will be learning and identifying different parts of our body and compare some changes we go through as we get older. We will also explore senses through practical activities and understand why these are important in everyday life. We will learn about the importance of healthy eating and exercise.

### SMSC

We will discover the importance of caring for and respecting our own bodies. We will learn about how we are all special in different ways.

### RE:

In RE we will be learning about Harvest and celebrating Navaratri. For our RE theme day, we will be focusing on Where do I belong? and What do I believe? We will be learning about Christianity and comparing it to Sikhism. We will be learning about our beliefs, important figures, God, Gurus,
