In the first two races we were also **1<sup>st</sup>** overall, but St. Peter's are close behind in 2<sup>nd</sup> place

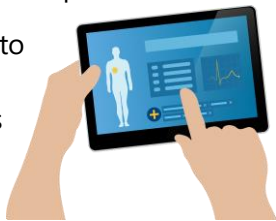

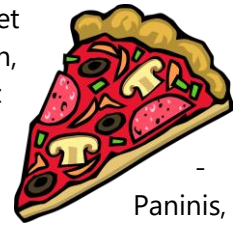
