School re-opens on **Tuesday 7th January 2020**.

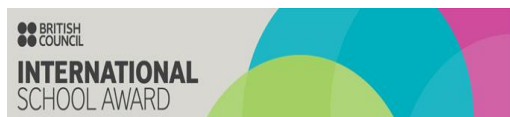
