Show and Tell

'Show and Tell' will take place every Wednesday and the newsletter will state the theme of the topic. Your child can bring in anything related to this topic, for example a book, a photo or a toy. Please help the children practise something to say about the item they bring in, to help them share it with the class. This improves their speaking and listening skills and encourage children to ask relevant questions too.

Also please help them to practise putting on their shoes and socks.
