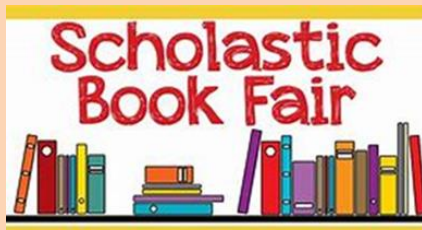

## Road Closure



We have been informed by United Utilities that as of Monday 4<sup>th</sup> Nov, there will be a road closure in place on Bradlegh Road near the junction with Wargrave Road adjacent to Scissor Sisters hair salon. This will have an impact on your journey to school by car as it is pedestrian access only and is estimated to take 14 days. The other entrance onto Bradlegh Road near Aldi will still be accessible to vehicles. Please bear this in mind on our return to school after the half term break and allow extra time for your journey. Thank you.

Also, on our return, the zebra crossing on Wargrave Road will no longer be patrol operated, this will become a Puffin Crossing which is signal operated.
