A little bit about us...

PrimeVR uses Virtual Reality (VR) to open a pupil's imagination and bring learning to life. Taking pupils on school trips is a great way of learning but it's not always possible. We aim to fill this gap by giving pupils the opportunity to see places from all over the world.

How does it work?

Pupils will either share a VR headset or have their own. Using VR headsets (similar to binoculars) pupils will be able to see a 360° perspective of the place they are visiting, almost giving them the feeling of being there. For example, if pupils are learning about Ancient Egypt, we will be able to take them to see the Pyramids of Giza and the Great Sphinx.

What are the benefits?

VR gives pupils a different perspective. Not only does it help to inspire creative writing but it also gives pupils the chance to develop their knowledge. Each session will be led by a PrimeVR team member who will be sharing facts and asking questions. This is an interactive session and pupils will be encouraged to discuss what they've seen, ask questions and be curious!

Is it suitable for everyone?

VR is used in many different sectors, from education and entertainment through to healthcare and construction. **We recommend that if your child has epilepsy or is prone to seizures that you consult with a doctor before using a VR headset.** As an alternative, we are able to set up the devices so that they can be used in 2D mode.
