Reading Meeting

Thursday, 7th November 3:30-4:15

This meeting is to tell you about how we teach early reading skills, to share the end of year expectations and to give you some top tips when reading with your child. A crèche will be available in Cherry Class from 3:25 till the end of the meeting for your Reception child and older/ younger siblings if they are happy to be left there. If attending please collect your child as normal at 3:15. We will open the crèche at 3:25.

Drop In

Wednesday, 13th November 3:30-4:00

This is a session you can choose to drop into if you wish but is not compulsory. I will be assisting if you are experiencing any difficulties with our Tapestry, Marvellous Me or Bug Club. If you are up and running with these there is no need to 'drop in'!

Open Classroom

Wednesday, 27th November 3:30-4:15

This is a parent's session run by the children, they are in charge. After all children are collected, we open our doors and it is an opportunity for you to be shown round the classroom by your child. They can show you their work on the walls, their books, the different learning areas of the classroom, carpet spaces are often identified too!
