## Maths

This half term we are learning to:

Number: Identify tens and ones in numbers to 50 compare numbers using more than, less than, equal to, count backwards and forwards in twos from 0 to 20.

Telling the time: read o'clock times, know and order days of the week.

Measurement: use non-standard units to measure and compare the weight, height and capacity of objects,

## English

This half term we are learning to:

Map a story to help us understand its structure. Write letters, postcards and stories based on The Jolly Postman. Write a newspaper article based on the Wright Brothers' invention. Create and film an advert for a chair for baby bear.

Recognise and use capital letters, use finger spaces between words and full stops at the end of a sentence with increasing independence.

Develop our ambitious vocabulary.

## Other

Science - **Identify** different animals. **Classify and compare** animals by diet (herbivore, omnivore and carnivore) and animal group eg reptile, amphibian etc.

History: **History of Flight** exploring the invention of the aeroplane and **evaluating** the significance of different key events.

**Comparing** the lives of the Wright Brothers and Amy Johnson.

Music - **singing**. Learning to use voices expressively.

PE - **gymnastics** balancing on points and patches.

**Throwing and catching**. Build a range of ball

RE - **How do we celebrate?** Exploring a range of celebrations such as Diwali, Eid and Christmas.

### Enrichment activities:

Please also help your child by reading regularly with them at home. Even 10 minutes reading 3-5 times a week will be helpful. Reading a bed-time story with your child will also help develop their vocabulary and understanding of language.
