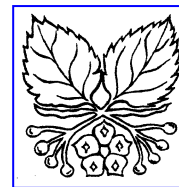

This year, we have decided to support this in a 'SPOTACULAR' way by:

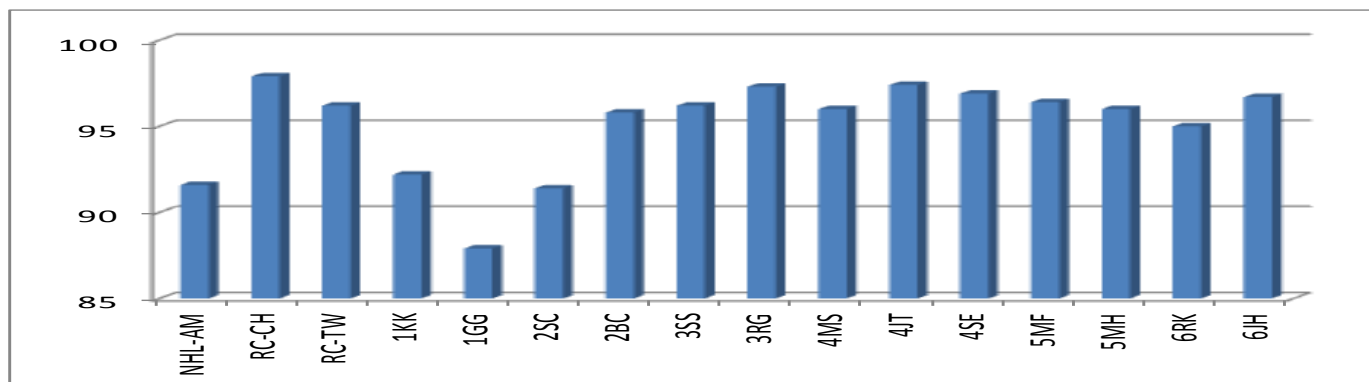
- Holding a Bring and Buy Sale
