Dear parents,



## Other News at Stockingford Academy...

### End of Day

The safe collection of over 600 children takes place on the school site every day. We very much need your support to help us manage this difficult and potentially unsafe part of the day, so please ensure that:

- You are here to collect on time
- You walk to school, if at all possible
- You know where your child is at all times, once the class is dismissed

If you are unable to collect on time, please call the school office and arrange for Stars Wraparound Club to help. The cost for our after school session is £7.50 which includes a snack, fruit and drinks and the session runs from 3:15-6:00pm.

At Stockingford Academy we prefer parents to use our online cashless payment system called SIMS Pay to pay for trips, club activities, school dinners and wraparound provision.

You can pay online using most major debit and credit cards, so you don't have to worry about you or your child carrying cash to school. You can have peace of mind that payments are made safely and securely..

Payments can be made online whenever and wherever you like, 24 hours a day, 7 days a weeks - all you need is access to the internet.

Within SIMS Pay, you can see exactly how much money has been paid for trips and meals without having to ring the school office; you can also see messages and trip letters coming up or needing payment. This means you have the freedom to keep on top of payments and avoid having to find the correct change at the last minute.

There are a few simple instructions to follow before you can start paying online.
