BLUE BUTTERFLY

On Tuesday we had PCSO's in school delivering the Blue Butterfly scheme. Children discussed the butterfly feeling in their tummy that they may get if they experience bullying, domestic violence, abuse or exploitation. Children created their own 'Hand of Trust' to show who they could go to if they needed to talk to someone. Children in Reception, Year 1 & 2 will complete their session on Monday morning.
