

Maths



In Maths we will be looking at:

- Counting to 5, 10 and above
- Continuing to recognise numbers to 5
- Using apparatus to 1:1 count to 3, 5, 10 and higher.
- Exploring 2D shapes.

To help with this at home you could count cars, look at door numbers as you come to Nursery or numbers in the shops.

PSED

The children are getting to know their new classroom environment and familiarising themselves with the adults.

They are developing an understanding of how to work together and take turns.



Phonics

In Phonics we will be looking at:

- Tuning into sounds.
- Recognising familiar sounds from the environment.
- Beginning to explore creating sounds themselves.

At home you could discuss sounds you hear when you are out and about or at home.



Literacy

In Literacy we will be looking at:

Stories about the theme such as 'The Gruffalo's Child' and 'The Christmas Story'. We will be sequencing stories and retelling them using a range of actions. Children will be encouraged to join in with repeated phrases from the story and recall key information from the books.

At home continue to enjoy stories and rhymes and talk about what has happened.
