



What happened in school this week?

This week our topic is,

'Why Do Leaves Go Crispy?'

This week in nursery we have been reading, 'Percy the Park Keeper' and the children have been predicting what might happen next in the story and they have been retelling the story using props and puppets. The children have then drawn their favourite part of the story.



We have also been looking at rhyming words in stories, poems and books. The children have matched pictures of objects that rhyme and they have had fun making up nonsense words that rhyme.



We have also compared and ordered objects of different sizes. We have used the story, 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears' to help us with this.

Finally we have started to talk about 'Remembrance Day' with the children and the reason why people wear commemorative poppies. The children have also had a go at making their own poppy.



Next Week— We carry on with topic,

'Why Do Leaves go Crispy?'

Next week we will be continuing with our 'Percy the Park Keeper' story so that the children will be able to retell the story confidently. We will continue to practise our rhyming strings through stories, poems and songs.
