Please make them as colourful as possible and with no writing.

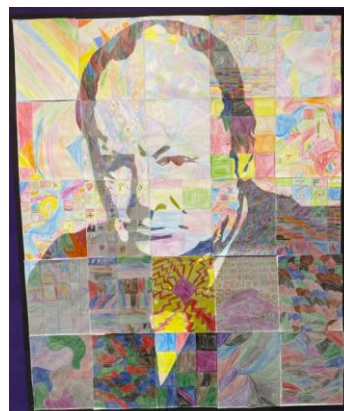
