South Belfast Foodbank is our local foodbank. You may have seen the volunteers collecting in Newtownbreda Tesco.

They have been operating for 5 years out of Mornington Community Project on the Ormeau Road, Friendship House just off Sandy Row and Common Grounds café in University Avenue. They have been wanting to open a distribution centre closer to our area for some

time and have recently opened up a **Tuesday session using Belvoir Community Hub from 2pm to 4pm.**

They want everyone to know that the foodbank is there to help anyone who needs a bit of help through a difficult patch. It might just be one parcel to help when you have had an unexpected bill or more support through a period of illness or benefit delays etc.
