We are planning to offer a phonics and reading workshop next as this seems to be the area which the most support and guidance is needed. We will be sending out a date for Term 3.

Our firework display was a roaring success last week with almost £2000 raised from the ticket sales, merchandise and refreshments bought on the night. Thank you to all those parents, grand parents, aunts, uncles and family friends who supported us. Thank you to the parents who helped to man stalls on the evening.
