Scholastic Book fair is in the school hall next week. The school receives commission on all purchases, which we then use to buy more reading books for our class libraries. To avoid any disappointment we strongly urge you to make your purchases by 3:30pm 4th December.** This year we will not be sending tickets home. Details of tickets purchased will be checked on admittance to each performance.
