### Uniform orders – November 2019

We have changed our uniform supplier to 'Your School Uniform' (YSU) and have made some changes to our uniform ordering system. We no longer hold any uniform in the school office but we will continue to sell book bags. You are now able to order uniform throughout the year directly with YSU using their online ordering system:

Enter the school name to find our school then click on the school logo to go to the school page.

As you go through the ordering system, there will be an option of consolidated delivery (no charge) or delivery to home (£3.99 charge or free with orders over £70).

Consolidated delivery means that your order is delivered to school with the next scheduled delivery.

Our next delivery date is 11.12.19. The cut-off date for ordering is midnight on 19.11.19.

You can register and purchase uniform using a debit or credit card. If you prefer, you can print off your order online and send it with a cheque.

There are areas on the website to provide you with answers to questions such as size information or frequently asked questions (FAQs). If you experience any difficulties, please contact the school office.

### Infant/Primary Admissions

If your child was born between 1 September 2014 and 31 August 2016 you need to apply to Derbyshire County Council for a primary school place for them. Even if you have already approached a school, or feel you have put your child's name down at a school, you need to make an application. The closing date for applications is midnight on Wednesday, 15 January 2020. You can fill an application form – either online - [www.derbyshire.gov.uk/admissions](http://www.derbyshire.gov.uk/admissions) or by phone – 01629 537499 – this takes approximately 15 minutes. If your child has a statement of special education needs or an Education Health care Plan contact the county council's SEND Central Team on 01629 536531 or 01629 536547.
