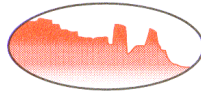

Middlesbrough food bank Christmas Collection

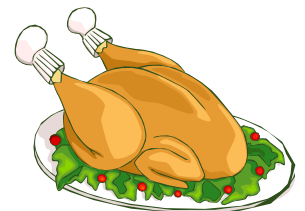
There is a school collection for Middlesbrough food bank on Friday 29th November. Please check the link below for items urgently required by the food bank.
