



### Parent Pay Information

## This is the last week that we can accept cash or paper dinner slips.

All school meals, trips and other items should be paid for using Parent Pay. To sign up for Parent Pay, you will need the Username and Password sent to you on a letter a few weeks ago. If you have 2 or more children, they can be connected on the same account. Just click on 'Add a child'.

Please read the instructions below on how to book a school meal.

When you log in to Parent Pay, click on the house icon. You should have your child's name then underneath a blue rectangle which says 'Make Meal Bookings'. Click on this and it will take you to a page called 'Child's Name Bookings'. Make sure the drop down box is set for lunch time (if you need breakfast club, it should be set to Breakfast) and the week commencing is the week you want to order for (please note you can only order up to midnight on the Sunday before the week commences for meals and up to 4pm the day before for breakfast).

Click on Make or View bookings then scroll down the page. On the menu at the bottom of the page, select which item is required per day. After you have chosen the meals, scroll down and click on 'Confirm Bookings'. You should then have a pop up that says how much you need to pay or 'there is no charge for this meal' if your child is in KS1 or entitled to Free School Meals.

There is also a yellow rectangular box with other payments which are linked to your account. This could be a school trip or a club for example.

Once the system is up and running, it is very simple to use.
