



Homework

The aim of our homework policy is to promote learning beyond the school day as an essential part of good education. We believe that homework not only reinforces classroom learning. It also helps children and young people to develop skills and attitudes that they need for successful lifelong learning.

Daily Reading/Spellings

Children in all classes have a home reading book and are expected to read daily for at least 10 minutes. Please sign your child's reading record to show their teacher you are supporting your child with this. Pupils in years 1-6 also receive spellings each week to be practised at home each evening.

Weekly homework

Each individual class teacher organises their homework timetable differently. Please see them if you are unsure of what this timetable is. Please support your child in completing their homework and don't hesitate to contact your child's class teacher if they have struggled with a certain piece of work.

Important

Your child's homework must be completed and handed in on time. Children who do not complete homework will be supported in doing so in school. However, your child's class teacher will contact you if more than two pieces of homework are not completed.

In KS2, if three pieces of homework are not completed in a term, your child will complete the homework in an after school catch up session. This will last until 4.15pm and will be at a time convenient for the class teacher and yourself.
