Prime Areas

The children have been busy making Christmas decorations. We have also made costumes for the nativity.

In PE, the children have been learning their dances for the nativity and thinking about the different ways that they can move their bodies to music.

In Communication and Language, the children have been talking about the changes that they observed during Forest School and looking for the elf.

Specific Areas

In literacy, the children have been learning all about the elves and writing special letters to post through the elves' door! We have started talking about why we celebrate Christmas. We have continued to recap the sounds that we have learnt so far:
