IMPORTANT INFORMATION

We have received the following advice from Public Health England:

Schools are experiencing increased reporting of diarrhoea and vomiting in school aged children consistent with viral gastroenteritis. This is often caused by Norovirus, a frequent cause of vomiting and diarrhoea in the community during the winter. Those reporting diarrhoea and vomiting should exclude themselves from school until 48 hours after the vomiting and/or diarrhoea have stopped. This is an important control measure which aims to limit the spread of infection to others.

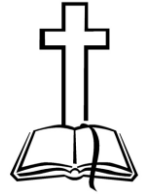


AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS
