The Flora Gardens Governors and I are continuing to work with Hammersmith & Fulham Council to explore options to redevelop the school's site in order to provide a high-quality new school, alongside new homes.

It's part of Hammersmith & Fulham Council's new Schools Renewal Programme which aims to improve school facilities and educational attainment by providing new high-quality, well- designed schools.

Since I last wrote to you the brief that described our ambitions has been further developed. That brief had considerable input from the pupils, staff, Governors and you, the parents.

We're now ready to ask parents, local residents and everyone who uses the school and its facilities to provide their views on the future of the site and how you would like to see it developed.

There will be a drop-in exhibition at the start of the design development process, which will be an opportunity to meet the architects, see our initial analysis of the site and share your ideas about the new school, community facilities and residential accommodation proposed for the site.

School finishes at 1.30pm on Thursday and there are no after school clubs on this day.

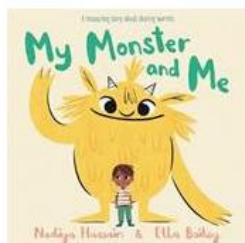

For ages 3-5 and up

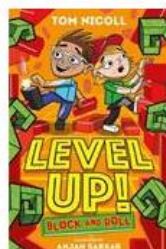


My Monster and Me

For ages 5-8 and up

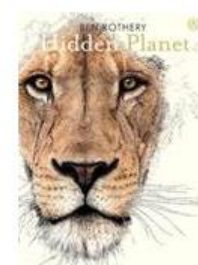


Level Up! Block and Roll
