#### Clubs

#### Primary Admission for September 2020

If your child has a 4<sup>th</sup> Birthday between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2019 & 31 August 2020 they will start primary school in September 2019. You will still need to apply for a place even if your child attends a nursery linked to a primary school. The deadline for applications is 15<sup>th</sup> January 2020. #### PE KITS

**It is essential that the children have a full P.E. Kit in school every day.**

Physical education is a statutory part of the National Curriculum with children receiving a minimum of 2 sessions of PE a week. Kits need to be in every day as additional Sport sessions can be added and session times can change.

Your child's PE kit **MUST** include:

- White or team colour (blue, green, red, yellow) T-shirt & black or blue shorts
- Pumps (gym in the hall) & Trainers (outdoors)
- Tracksuit bottoms for outdoor sessions in colder weather (optional)
