



Area of learning	What we will be learning
<p>English</p> 	<p><u>READING</u> This week we will be using and exploring an Atlas. We will look at a world map and try to track the journey of the Penguin family in our class text Poles Apart.</p> <p><u>WRITING</u> WE will follow the Pilchard-Browns as Mr White helps them to find their way back to their home in the South Pole. On the way they encounter different countries and we will use our geography and English skills to develop our knowledge of the world by finding out a little about each country (America, Italy, India, Australia). Please talk to your child about any previous experiences you or they may have had in these countries. Any photos/artefacts and memories will be SUPER to share 😊</p>
<p>Phonics</p> 	<p><u>PHONICS phase 5</u> This week this group will learn alternatives for the /ai/ sound (ay a-e ai) https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/ username: jolesfield (lowercase j) Password: Jolesfield (uppercase J)</p> <p><u>GPS</u> This week we will continue to learn about adding the suffix ed to verbs (past tense) Some of us might learn what happens if words end in an e and words that require you to double the final consonant (e.g. hop, skip, tap)</p> <p><u>PHASE 3</u> This week we will revise the diagraphs ch and sh.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p><u>NUMBER</u> This week we will revise addition using the + and = signs. All of us will add numbers one and two-digit numbers to 20 (e.g. 12+4) and some of us will add one and two digit numbers to numbers to 100 (e.g.34+45). We will all move onto using pictorial representations to support our addition. Some of us may begin to be able to do this mentally.</p>
<p>Topic</p> 	<p><u>E-Safety</u> This half term we will be taught about the importance of keeping safe on the computer using CEOP's resources Lee and Kim. We will learn SID's Top Tips.</p> <p><u>GEOGRAPHY</u> This week we have an opportunity to work alongside the volunteers in school to help with our reflection garden. Please bring outdoor clothes, including suitable footwear to school by Wednesday.</p>
