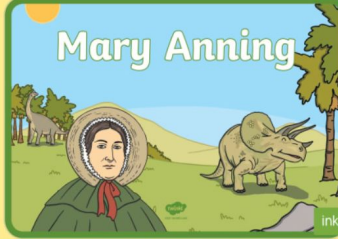
Term	Definition

Paleontologist	A scientist who studies fossils.

Mary Anning

Mary Anning: Lived in the UK. She found the first 'fish lizard'. She found the first fossil that belonged to a pterosaur. Some of her discoveries are displayed in the Natural History Museum in London.



Tyrannosaurs

A carnivore that was 12m high. It lived in swamps and forests. Even though it was big, it was very fast and ran at 16mph.



Brachiosaurs

Had longer front legs than back legs (it's a little like a giraffe). It got a lot of its food from trees using its long neck. It lived in forests. Height 23m



Stegosaurus

Has two rows of body plates along its back. It has a very small brain about the size of an apple. Size 9m long and lived in woodlands.



Pteranodon

Its wings were 9m wide. It had a long thin beak. It didn't have any feathers. It lived by the coast and eats fish.



Diplodocus

A herbivore with a huge long whip like tail. It uses its long neck to reach the treetops. Size 25m long, the length of 2 buses.



Triceratops

Had a head which had a frill and 3 horns which were used as weapons. Size 9m long, it lived in the forests and ate plants.

When dinosaurs lived this was called the Mesozoic Era.
