GYMNASTICS

There are spaces in both the KS1 and KS2 after School Gym Club. Each session costs £3.50 so a 6 week half term totals £21, payable in the first few weeks.

The first half term is for KS2. Our aim in these sessions is to give your child many of the basic gymnastic skills and to increase the difficulty of these skills as they progress. Over the half term, Dave Hulme, a fully qualified gymnastic coach from Idsall Gymnastics Club, will deliver these sessions in a safe and controlled environment.

Dave will follow the aims of the 'Gymnastics for All' program by British Gymnastics. This will provide your child with fun, fitness and friendship and contribute to their overall health and well-being.
