PE KITS

Physical education is a statutory part of the National Curriculum with children receiving a minimum of 2 sessions of PE a week. Kits need to be in every day as additional Sport sessions can be added and session times can change.

- White or team colour (blue, green, red, yellow) T-shirt & black or blue shorts
- Pumps (gym in the hall) & Trainers (outdoors)
- Tracksuit bottoms for outdoor sessions in colder weather (optional)

Adults entering school

As part of our Safeguarding & Health and Safety procedures unfortunately parents cannot enter school when dropping children off. Lateness

Lateness has a negative impact! Being late can:

Disrupt lessons Affect achievement Embarrass/upset your child.

Being late adds up to loss of learning:

5 minutes late every day = 3 days lost each year, **10 minutes** = 6 days lost each year

15 minutes = 10 days lost each year

Head Lice
