Please keep collecting – we need just under 100 stickers to complete our chart and secure ourselves some new sports equipment. Thanks in advance.

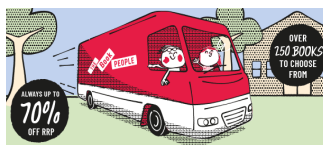
REPLACEMENT BADGES

These will be for sale from tomorrow (Tuesday) for children to buy in school.

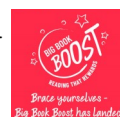
THE BOOK BUS
