HARVEST DONATIONS

We are asking for your donations of tinned goods, dry goods or toiletries to be in school by the beginning of the school day on Friday 11th October as they will be collected shortly after the start of the school day.

'FLU IMMUNISATION

Please complete your online consent (or otherwise) for your child for the 'flu immunisation programme as soon as possible. NHS staff will be in school to deliver the vaccinations on 31st October. School children receive the vaccination via a nasal spray; there are no needles involved.

CLASS 1 TRIP TO BATTRAM WOODS—Consent & payment due by 11th October

Our Class One trip to Battram Woods, near Ibstock, will take place on 24th October. The cost of the trip is £5 per child and this is to be paid via ParentPay as soon as possible, but by 11th October at the latest.
