The PTA have kindly purchased access to 'Times Table Rockstars' and the brand new 'NumBots' for every child in school to support curriculum learning in Maths and developing fluency in number and calculation. Both of these are accessed through one login either online or through the respective Apps available to download on any mobile device. We are currently in the process of setting up access to these for everyone and staff training and details will be sent home following our whole school launch on Monday 25th November. As part of this launch we are inviting children in Reception and Year 1 (Class 1) to come to school dressed as robots and children in years 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6 (Classes 2 and 3) to come dressed as rock stars for the day to celebrate this launch.

A huge thank you to parents and the local community for their support in helping us collect the ALDI sports vouchers we have completed one chart of 300 stickers and managed to half complete a second chart. By completing a full chart we have secured a school sports kit and have been entered into a competition to win £20,000 for sports development in school.

Next week we look forward to our Remembrance worship in school for the children as well as worships and class activities around Anti-Bullying including online bullying as it is National Anti-Bullying Week next week. This year's theme is titled 'Change starts with us' and we will be sharing some of our work on Twitter so please have a look.

SCHOOL DINNER MENU

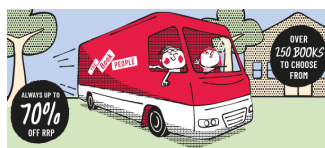
We are expecting some of the items on the school dinner menu to change shortly, as they have not been well received at a number of schools.
