


In the event that school needs to be closed this winter, you will be notified by text message as soon as a decision is made. Therefore, if any parent's mobile number has changed, please let us know as soon as possible (messages will go to parents only if permission has been granted to school to contact you via text). If other contacts need to be informed, it is parents responsibility to pass the message on. Details of the closure will be given to BBC Radio Leicester (104.9FM), to be broadcast on the radio and to be listed on their website but it is often difficult to contact the radio station as there are so many schools trying to call in at the same time. We will also put a notice on the school website and on our Twitter feed.

We will only close if absolutely necessary, but our main priority will always be to ensure the health, safety and wellbeing of staff, pupils and parents, some of whom travel quite a distance to get to school.

We have also reviewed our Winter access plans and in the event of icy conditions we ask that parents and children use the footpath next to the carpark towards Class 1 or come through the main entrance. The entrance to the left of the building around the staffroom and old Class 4 will be closed with signage by the bin store in the carpark. Access to Morning Club will be via the footpath towards Class 1 only and not via the main entrance.
