

**Weekly Overview**



**Year group: Reception and Year One**

Area of learning	What we will be learning
<p>Communication and Language Literacy (English)</p> 	<p>Our literacy focus this week continues with learning to write the story of Harry and the Bucketful of Dinosaurs. We shall be using Talk for Writing and the children will be working together to create actions to fit the story and then using these actions to help them write the story.</p> <p>Y1 In guided reading we shall be learning about dialogue in stories and how we use speech bubbles and speech marks to show when someone is talking.</p>
<p>Phonics</p> 	<p>Yr R: We shall be practising the sounds we have learnt s,a,t,p,i,n,d,m,d,g (Group 1) and 'ch', 'sh' and 'th' (Group 2). They will also be practising their blending and segmenting.</p> <p>Yr 1: The children in Year One will be continuing with Phase 5 phonics.</p>
<p>Mathematical Development</p>	<p>Yr R will be learning about the number 8 and using these to solve simple calculations within a number rhyme.</p> <p>Yr 1 will be continuing their work on place value and comparing numbers using mathematical vocabulary eg. greater than, less than, same as.</p>
<p>Personal, Social, and Emotional Development</p>	<p>We shall be learning to consider the needs of others and to accept the needs of others.</p>
<p>Expressive Arts and Design</p>	<p>The children will be making observational drawings of dinosaurs looking carefully at shapes and lines.</p>
<p>Understanding of the world</p>	<p>We shall be learning about different animal groups eg. reptile, mammal, bird, fish and how to group them according to their features.</p>
<p>Physical Development</p> 	<p>In PE we will be focussing on dance this half term. We will be thinking about how different dinosaurs might move and using these movements to create a short sequence to music.</p> <p><b>Changing clothes:</b> Thank you to everyone who is encouraging your children to get themselves dressed and undressed at home. Not only is this an important part of children developing independence at this age, it is also important in practical terms. We have two adults to help 22 Reception children, therefore they need to do the majority of the changing without support. Thank you.</p>

Please note this is a basic overview of the planning for this week. It is impossible to cover in this outline all the learning that takes place during a week! We also believe in listening to your children and responding to the children's interests and ideas therefore all our planning is **very** flexible. Please note some of the learning will take place across more than one week and during some weeks the learning focus may not cover all curriculum areas.
