

Dear Parents,

This week we have been focusing on our new book called 'No Bot'. The children really enjoyed this story and we have been using robots in all our stations.

During table top the children have been rolling a dice and practising their adding skills by adding cubes to their towers; they have been writing a sentence about where they think the robot has forgotten his things and making this into a book; making a puzzle; building a robot city and playing some games with Numicon.



This week the children have made their own stories for story-telling week. They have used some of their red words to help spell tricky words. They then made these into a story book to show their friends. They have also been making robots using junk modelling and these robots have become part of their play in the construction area. They have been making playdough and modelling these into different shapes and people to use in their stories. They have also learnt about a new artist called Kandinsky and creating their own paintings inspired by the works of Kandinsky. These are all displayed inside the classroom. The children made some of their own cards with red words to display and help them with their writing.

We have continued with our new letter this week and it is the letter Yud. We have learnt that it is the smallest letter in the Hebrew Aleph Bet and our action for this letter is to crawl up as small as we can! Thank you to those of you that have completed the home learning Aleph Bet sheets - keep it up! We have also been looking at the last 3 plagues and learning that Hashem is always helping us. We know that Paroh told the Jewish people to leave Mitzrayim (Egypt) quickly and we thought about all the things we would take if we had to hurry away, we made lists and packed our cases - a very busy time!
