At Stockingford Academy our current focus is on reading. All children in Reception and Key Stage 1 are developing their early reading skills through the phonics scheme, 'Read, Write Inc.' This is in addition to their English and guided reading sessions that all children enjoy daily. We were delighted to add lots of new reading books to the collections across the school which have now all been banded to ensure our children are reading books at just the right level. For those who need a little extra help, there are exciting interventions in groups or at an individual level happening throughout each day. **We now need your help too!** Your children bring home a reading diary and their reading book each day. We would love it if they could be heard to read at home and have you record in their reading diary how well they have done or if they needed any help. "Teamwork makes the dream work, folks!" Other News at Stockingford Academy

Height and Weight Measurement

In line with government guidelines, all children in reception and year 6 in Warwickshire are offered a height and weight measurement (National Child Measurement Programme). The School health and Wellbeing Service will be coming into school to complete these programmes with your child and you may be contacted about the results. It is recommended that the outcome of your child's weight is not shared with your child as it is for parents information only. If you have any concerns about your child's health or you would like to opt your child out of the height and weight measurements you can contact The School Health and Wellbeing Service on 03300 245 204. Good health is linked to educational attainment, therefore the healthier children are, the more likely they are to attend school regularly, focus and participate in lessons, and achieve their potential.
