

Weekly Overview



Year group: Reception and Year One

Date w/c: 3/2/20

Area of learning	What we will be learning
Communication and Language Literacy (English) 	We shall be using Stomp, Dinosaur, Stomp! this week in our Literacy and looking at descriptive language and adjectives used in this text. We shall be creating character profiles on our favourite dinosaur and using adjectives to describe how it moves and what it looks like.
Phonics 	Yr R: We shall be practising the sounds we have learnt s,a,t,p,i,n,d,m,d,g (Group 1) and 'ng', 'ee' and 'ai' (Group 2). They will also be practising their blending and segmenting. Yr 1: The children in Year One will be continuing with Phase 5 phonics.
Mathematical Development	Yr R will be learning about the number 9 and using these to solve simple calculations within a number rhyme. Yr 1 will be continuing their work on place value and building on their skills of ordering up to 10 and apply them to ordering three groups of abstract numbers up to 20.
Personal, Social, and Emotional Development	We shall be learning what it means to be a good friend and the qualities needed to be a good friend.
Expressive Arts and Design	The children will be painting the observational drawings of dinosaurs they did last week and learning how to mix colours as well as using their fine motor skills to paint within the lines.
Understanding of the world	We are learning about stories from the bible, Jesus' Friends and the story of David and Jonathan.
Physical Development 	In PE we will be focussing on dance this half term. We will be thinking about how different dinosaurs might move and using these movements to create a short sequence to music. Changing clothes: Thank you to everyone who is encouraging your children to get themselves dressed and undressed at home. Not only is this an important part of children developing independence at this age, it is also important in practical terms. We have two adults to help 22 Reception children, therefore they need to do the majority of the changing without support. Thank you.

Please note this is a basic overview of the planning for this week. It is impossible to cover in this outline all the learning that takes place during a week! We also believe in listening to your children and responding to the children's interests and ideas therefore all our planning is **very** flexible. Please note some of the learning will take place across more than one week and during some weeks the learning focus may not cover all curriculum areas.
