



Area of learning	What we will be learning
<p><b>English</b></p>   	<p><b>READING</b></p> <p>This week in guided reading we will be finding out about what it is like to go to the Antarctic on a boat with nine year old Sophie as she starts a month long voyage with her dad, Sophie recounts the adventure of a lifetime in her own words, illustrations, and colour photographs. She'll show us icebergs, penguins, seals, and whales! It's a dangerous journey, but Sophie is well prepared for the thrills and chills that await her! We will use our reading to enhance our own diary writing.</p> <p><b>WRITING</b></p> <p>We will be identifying Ernest Shackleton as a significant individual and using extracts of the texts to gain new information. We will be following Ernest's journey to the Antarctic. This week we will keep a diary of the events that unfold as Ernest and his crew undertake their expedition!</p>
<p><b>Phonics</b></p> 	<p><b>PHONICS – Phase 5</b></p> <p>Last week this group were introduced to alternatives for the /ai/ sound. They will continue to explore this and then move onto alternatives for /ee/</p> <p><b>Phase 3</b></p> <p>This group are learning the sounds igh and oa.</p> <p><b>GPS</b></p> <p>This week we will continue to learn about adding the suffix ed and ing to words. This week we will revise the spelling rules so far (if a word ends in 'e' or 'y' ) and think about what happens when we need to double the consonant (usually after a short vowel sound)</p>
<p><b>Maths</b></p> 	<p><b>MEASURES</b></p> <p>This week we will recognise and know the value of different denominations of coins and notes. We will choose objects and pay for them in a variety of ways (50p = 10p 10p 10p 10p or 20p 20p 10p or 50p). Some of us will add objects together to find totals and then find ways to pay and some of us might be able to work out giving change.</p> <p><b>HOME LEARNING IDEA</b></p> <p>Set up a toyshop or car boot sale at your home. Keep most items under 20p and let the children use real money to work out how to pay for things (1 item at a time). Then let them be the shopkeeper. Can they check you have paid the right amount?</p>
<p><b>Topic</b></p>	<p><b>E-Safety</b></p> <p>This half term we will be taught about the importance of keeping safe on the computer using CEOP's resources Lee and Kim.</p> <p>We will learn SID's Top Tips.</p> <p><b>SCIENCE</b></p> <p>We will continue to think about the changes in the seasons with a focus upon Winter (day length, weather patterns in the UK, features in nature during winter)</p>
<p><b>Other information</b></p>	<p><b>INSET DAY - Monday 24<sup>th</sup> February</b></p> <p><b>DT week – Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> February. Keep collecting those 'vehicle shaped' boxes for us 😊</b></p>
