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## This Week at Stockingford

Dear Parents,

Although I am not aware of any of our families travelling back from China, I am sharing the information below as requested by Public Health, England:

We would like to share the following information with you about the current situation regarding the Wuhan Coronavirus originating from China.

It has been confirmed that two patients in England have tested positive for coronavirus. The patients are receiving specialist NHS care.

Based on the World Health Organization's declaration that this is a public health emergency of international concern, **the UK Chief Medical Officers have raised the risk to the public from low to moderate**. However the risk to individuals in the UK has not changed at this stage.

It is now recommended that all travellers who **develop relevant symptoms, however mild**, within 14 days of returning from mainland China, should self-isolate at home immediately and call NHS 111.

However, if you have specifically returned from Wuhan or Hubei province in the last 14 days, **please follow this advice even if you do not have symptoms of the virus:**

- stay indoors and avoid contact with other people as you would with other flu viruses
- call NHS 111 to inform them of your recent travel to the city
