Hi all — one week to go!

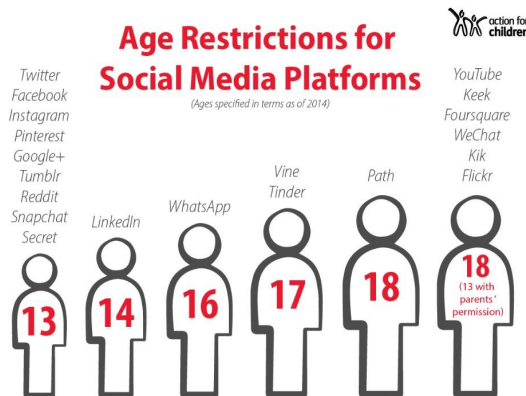
