


Area of learning	What we will be learning
English  	<p><u>READING</u> This week in guided reading we will be finding out about what it is like to go to the Antarctic on a boat with nine year old Sophie as she starts a month long voyage with her dad, Sophie recounts the adventure of a lifetime in her own words, illustrations, and colour photographs. She'll show us icebergs, penguins, seals, and whales! It's a dangerous journey, but Sophie is well prepared for the thrills and chills that await her! We will use our reading to enhance our own diary writing.</p> <p><u>WRITING</u> We will continue to follow Ernest's journey to the Antarctic. This week we will keep a diary of the events that unfold as Ernest and his crew undertake their expedition!</p>
Phonics 	<p><u>PHONICS – Phase 5</u> Last week this group were introduced to alternatives for the /ee/ sound. They will continue to explore this and then move onto alternatives for /igh/ <u>Phase 3</u> This group are learning the sounds oo ar <u>GPS</u> This week we will learn more exception words.</p>
Maths 	<p><u>NUMBER</u> This week we will learn about fractions of number. We will start by revising our knowledge of fractions of shape and then begin to apply this to fractions of quantities. All of us will be able to recognise , find and name halves and quarters of numbers and some of us will be able to recognise 1/3, ¼, 2/4, ¾ of numbers and recognise the equivalence of ½ and 2/4.</p>
Topic 	<p><u>E-Safety</u> This half term we will be taught about the importance of keeping safe on the computer using CEOP's resources. This week we will look at Jessie and her friends. https://www.thinkuknow.co.uk/parents/jessie-and-friends-videos/</p> <p><u>SCIENCE</u> We will continue to think about the changes in the seasons with a focus upon Winter (day length, weather patterns in the UK, features in nature during winter)</p>
